

#### Music News:

#### Welcome Mark Jacobson as our New Music Director

One of the reasons that I am a musician is because music expresses what words cannot. Yet here I am, fumbling around for language to describe the workings of the Holy Spirit and an unexpected call to be your new music director at the Federated Community Church. So here it goes; Hi, I'm Mark Jacobson and I'm going to be the new music director at FCC. I've been an organist and choir director for about 40 years. Hampden FCC will be my fourth church serving in that capacity. I started singing in a junior choir at age 6 and with the exception of some colorful lapses during my college years, have been doing so ever since. I know a lot of hymns but not all of them. I understand the nature of choirs but I still get surprised. I like to believe that I'm organized and prepared - most of the time. I love the Lord – always.

And with that, we look to our shared future. We are going to make some music for the glory of God. Normally, this is the point at which I would announce resuming Thursday night choir rehearsals with an enthusiastic "welcome all who have a voice to raise!" That moment is coming but not quite yet. Right now, loving our neighbor means protecting each other from Covid and it's really hard to sing while on a respirator.

So, we're going to start small. In Advent we'll be seeking musicians (solo singers, duets, instrumentalists of any kind) to heighten our worship experience with musical offerings. Even if you don't think that your gift is "good enough" or even "usable," talk to me anyway. A church musical ministry is a lot like a church pot-luck; everybody brings a little something to the table and before you know it, you have a feast. That's how I perceive my role; as one who crafts and shapes a spectrum of gifts and talents into an offered musical meal. Sometimes it's green Jello salad, sometimes it's tuna noodle casserole. It all feeds us. It's all good.

You'll hear me repeat this phrase often. "It is good to give God thanks and praise." No other reason is necessary other than it is "good" to do so. I believe the world needs more random acts of

goodness and beauty. I am honored and humbled to be called to serve as your new Music Director. I promise to try my best to be worthy of the task. I pray that together we will make the world a better and kinder place by making music here in this place at this time; in this sweet corner of the world, in your beautiful church on the banks of the Scantic.
