## From the Pastor's Desk

A Church where the Next Generation is Happier

We would like to shift our ministry focus slowly to children. For the last 6 months, our ministry focus was worship. We formed new ministry teams, such as the Welcome Team, Prayer Team, and Worship Team. And we are now forming the Praise Team. These teams mainly support worship. If I need to say the age group we focused on so far, I would say it was 50+.

And now, we would like to support the children and the families with children. They are the future of our church as well as our Christian faith. As we heard and learned the gospel from our parents or grandparents when we were young, we should deliver the gospel to the next generation. It's our turn.

What I am thankful to God for is that we have a wonderful Christian Education (CE) team. Linda Hornig, one of our lay spiritual leaders, is leading the team. Jocelyn Smith, the coordinator, has two master's degrees and has deep Biblical knowledge with passion and love for children. Moreover, ALL teaching volunteers are active or retired public school teachers in MA. Every team member is professional, experienced, and full of love, especially for the children's education. We have a dream team!

Moreover, we, as a team, are now studying for a better Christian curriculum for Sunday School. Sunday School is a precious time to teach our children the Christian faith. It is not just playtime or babysitting. It is when children learn and accept Jesus as their Savior. The current curriculum is good, but we would like to provide the best curriculum for our children. Please pray for that.

Finally, we would like to support our children financially for this coming PA trip, which will be April 23-25. During the trip, we will see a Biblical show, "Daniel," at the Sight & Sound Theater and have an Amish Country tour. Children will learn how Daniel kept his faith in God from childhood and how God blessed and used him for His glory. And we will see how Amish people keep their faith and rear their children in the Christian faith even in the 21st century. It will be truly a valuable time for everyone.

However, the trip is in the mid-week days and right after the Spring break. It's not the best time for children. Moreover, the trip cost (\$539 per person) would be too high for a family to bring children. So, we decided to cover the FULL payment for each and every child if they are going.

Jocelyn (CE coordinator) and I will prepare a 4–6-week special curriculum for Children's Moment and Sunday School with the story of Daniel before the trip. We plan to have a separate gathering time for children and their families each night of the trip so that they may share what they learn and think. This will be a wonderful opportunity for children to learn the Christian faith with great experience.

To receive this scholarship, the child should be our child or grandchild. They must attend the 4–6-week special Children's Moment and Sunday School. Either their parent(s) or grandparent(s) should go with the child. Children's age should be 12 and under, and the children should understand the Children's Moment and Sunday School.

I don't know how many children can join the trip. Even if no child can join, we just would like to give our hearts to them. This is my hope. Federated Community Church becomes the church where the next generation is happier.

#### From the Deacons' Bench

#### THE MEANING OF LENT

Lent is a period of 40 days observed by most Christians in preparation of Easter.

It begins on Ash Wednesday and ends on Maundy Thursday which is the day Christ was betrayed after the last supper and then arrested before his crucifixion on the cross 3 days before Easter. The duration of Lent is based on the 40 days that Jesus Christ spent fasting in the desert and enduring temptations by Satan according to the New Testament gospels of Matthew, Mark and Luke.

The practice of fasting during Lent involves abstaining from certain types of food, mainly meat and dairy products for a specific period of time. It is also a period of giving up or sacrificing something important to you as a remembrance of the sacrifices made by Jesus Christ for us. This is also a time for thoughtful prayer to reflect on your own faith and seek spiritual renewal.

The word Lent comes from the Old English word "Lencten" meaning March or lengthening in regards to daylight during spring. The timing of Easter is tied to the lunar calendar which the people of Israel used at the time of Christ.

During this season of Lent let us make an effort to take some time to reflect, pray and help the poor.
